Each time we visit the guys (Tuesdays) at Vida Jovenes down the street from where we live it's a new adventure - new faces each week and some of the guys we were barely getting to know have left, God willing for a better life free in Christ. This last Tuesday (photo-left) we had the guys sit according to age from 14 years old (front-right) to 27 years old (guy behind the post) - when I asked the guys why was homie still here (after 12 years) they

mentioned he's been In & Out like the hamburger - "He can't get enough of this place Walt, so he keeps coming back!"

At least the gentleman smiled about it and mentioned he really wants to be set free - for the next 40 minutes we just talked about the gospel, the good news, "Las buenas noticias", Jesus the Saviour, how He has redeemed us with His Blood, John 3:16, Romans 1:16, and every other scripture that talks about being "set free" from the previous lifestyle (drugs, alcohol, mayhem), then we all joined hands and each said a prayer - "Lord take over - we don't want to ever come back to this place again - set us free, set us apart, and let your will be done", and a bunch of other words the guys used to voice their displeasure with their previous lifestyle, sincerely wanting to be set free, and having this amazing reverence for the Lord - all 25 of them that were present that day prayed from their hearts - I have never seen a sincere hunger like this for the Lord in a very long time . . . these guys eat, drink, breath in the Word of God 24/7 . . .

I told the guys that the popcorn machine (photo-back) and soda pop were provided by some amazing people back in the States who, without even seeing or knowing them provided those blessings as an expression of their love and what God has done for them - we were just spreading that love.

Please continue to pray for our new "adopted" sons - that as they cycle thru the rehab home they walk out like sons of the risen King and *never* go back to that lifestyle they so much desire to leave behind - God is faithful!

A Camping We Went - My wife (photo-right) ended up taking 5 of our girls camping over the weekend and it was really neat to see the gals jell together as a team and enjoy each other's company - Sayra (16), Xochi (14), Mariana (14), Kimberly (14), and Yamilet (12) ate a LOT of good food, had a lot of Good Word, swimming, activities, devotionals, and just right now as I'm writing this newsletter (1:30am) my wife is finishing up her last devotional/prayer time with the girls in their tent.

The only downside about this camping trip was there were mosquitos everywhere, from early morning to about 7pm, then they just disappeared. With my O+ blood I was the feast at the banquet until my wife covered me with some liquid which held them at bay . . . no one else got harrassed, just me!

THANK YOU from the bottom of our hearts - you provided a new tent (photo-right),

4 new lawn chairs, a new sleeping bag, a new cooler, and a ton of amazing food we are still feasting on including tomorrow morning.

Unfortunately, some of our girls were not allowed to participate - we had to convince the parents of Yamilet that it was okay to let their daughter venture out of the house and just be a kid . . .

Yamilet - Only 12 (l-r, photos), looks like 10, apparently has been battling depression all year (according to mom), has the lowest GPA of all of our kids, and when I asked the gals when was the first time (age) your parents let you walk down to the corner store to buy something, Yamilet mentioned it was just last week! Her mom wanted us to send photos of her every hour to make sure she was okay, that she missed her so much (not even gone 24 hours) and wanted her to come back soon - it would appear mom might have a problem.





Yamilet, when she's with us is full of life, full of smiles, full of laughs, and just a regular kid who wants to blossom into that princess for the Lord . . .

PLEASE pray for Yamilet - she mentioned she doesn't want to go back home because she is having TOO much fun and it feels so nice to be out of the house! Please pray that her mom would tone it down a bit and just let her daughter be who God wants her to be . . .

as nice) here in our beloved Mexico.
